

# Five Boro Bike Tour: Michigan man dies during race, NYPD says

A 51-year-old Michigan man has died after suffering a heart attack during the annual New York City-wide bicycle tour, police said.

Michael Boren went into cardiac arrest Sunday morning after crossing the Ed Koch [Queensboro Bridge](#) that links Queens and Manhattan, police said. He was taking part in the 40-mile TD Five Boro Bike Tour.

Authorities say he was declared dead on arrival at New York Weill Cornell Medical Center.

Boren lived in Almont, Mich., north of Detroit.
